

Summary of Findings - Dundas Youth Surveys

Main Conclusions

- 96% of participants in this survey live in Dundas, Ontario
- Majority of participants ranked a person or place to help with drug/alcohol addictions and part-time employment as very important. The majority of participants ranked social activities and a person or place to help with mental health concerns as important (see Figure 2).



- Many participants stated miscellaneous comments that would improve their life in Dundas. Some common themes were related to *less bullying, more things to do within Dundas, better transportation, and easier/better access to health services* (such as mental health services).
- The majority of participants stated that they would attend a *cooking group, and many expressed interest in a social skills group, thoughts and feelings group, or learn to run group.*
