


Dundas Family Survey Results




Main Conclusion

The majority of participants in this group live in Dundas, Ontario.



When asked which resources are most important, the majority of participants ranked **recreational activities, social activities, a person/place to help with mental health concerns, transportation, and a safe space with no bullying as very important**. Volunteer opportunities and part-time employment nearby were more popularly ranked as important as opposed to very important. **There were mixed rankings for a person/place to deal with drug/alcohol addictions** as a similar number of people felt as though this was an important resource, an important resource, neutral, or not very important.

There were many qualitative comments left for **Questions 3, 4 and 5** of the survey regarding services or



resources that would improve the lives of those living in Dundas. The themes from those comments are as follows.

Transportation Issues	Recreation	Crime	Conservation Areas	Community
This theme includes concerns with public transit, driving out of town, cycling lanes, difficultly parking, and seniors driving.	This theme includes an expressed interest in more youth and programming activities, and a better recreation center.	This theme includes concerns with halfway houses, illicit drug use, and left. This theme also includes an expressed want in a greater police presence.	This theme includes an expressed interest in trail access and improvement of the cleanliness, litter, and safety standards of the current conversation areas.	This theme includes concerns with the lack of jobs and volunteer opportunities in Dundas, expensive housing, and in-affordable shopping. This theme also includes an expressed interest in more health services, and more community events.

Many participants **expressed personal interest in the *cooking group, learn to run group, social skills group, and the thoughts and feelings group***. Many participants stated that **their youth would attend the *learn to run group and the social skills group***. Limited number of participants selected that themselves and their youth would be interested in both types of *drug/alcohol support groups*.
